The latest amendments to IMO's IBC code will come into force on January 1, 2021 for both newbuilds and in-service chemical tankers. Owners and operators will need to assess the impact of new transportation conditions laid out in the IBC Code on the list of chemical products their vessels currently transport.

Both Conventions require chemical tankers built after 1 July 1986 to comply with the International Code for the Construction and Equipment of Ships carrying Dangerous Chemicals in Bulk (IBC Code). The IBC Code provides an international standard for the safe carriage in bulk by sea of dangerous chemicals and noxious liquid substances listed in chapter 17 of the Code.

The IBC Code replaced the Code for the Construction and Equipment of Ships Carrying Dangerous Chemical in Bulk, which applies to chemical tankers built or converted before 1 July 1986.
