Developmental screening is more in-depth than monitoring and may identify children with a developmental risk that was not identified during developmental monitoring. The American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) recommends developmental and behavioral screening for all children during regular well-child visits at these ages: 9 months; 18 months; 30 months
